It takes approximately seven times to leave an abuser for good. We support our clients by caring for their basic needs to help them regain their independence.






CASE MANAGEMENT CLIENTS

Crisis case managers work with victims to help them move toward a future free from abuse. They connect victims with resources to help them become selfreliant, independent, and free.

KEY:



- Ada County: Provides the physical Faces of Hope Victim Center located at 417 S. 6th St. in Boise, 83702, to provide space for partners to provide victim services to the community. With thanks to support and annual approval from the Ada County Commissioners, this facility provides IT support, operational support and security for building occupants.
- Ada County Prosecutor's Office: Administers the Victim Center on behalf of the Board of County Commissioners. Attorneys with special training in the dynamics of domestic violence are available to meet with victims the day after a DV event to explain the legal system, next steps, and hear the victim's perspective.
- Adult Protective Services: Responds to allegations of abuse, neglect/self-neglect or financial exploitation of vulnerable adults. Provides appropriate resources and referrals. Offers education and training throughout the community on related issues.
- Boise Police Department: Law Enforcement investigates criminal allegations, including domestic violence, sexual assault, child abuse, and elder abuse. Victim Witness Coordinators, funded by the City of Boise, provide support and guidance through the criminal justice system process.
- **Boise State University/ Other University Interns**: Student interns serve as counselors or case managers in the Victim Center.
- Faces of Hope Foundation: Created in 2016 to help support victims of interpersonal violence, Faces of Hope Foundation helps those experiencing domestic violence, sexual assault, child abuse, elder abuse, stalking, and human trafficking. The foundation is a non-profit led by a board of community leaders. The Foundation provides direct support to victims of interpersonal violence by providing crisis counseling, case management, on-site legal services through Margo Anderson, JD and victim advocacy. Faces of Hope also offers tangible support to victims by providing gas and grocery cards, hotel vouchers, transportation costs, and more.
- Health and Welfare: Conducts investigations into child abuse, neglect and abandonment which may or may not amount to a crime. Participates in the court process regarding civil Child Protection cases. Place children into protective placements. Provides case management for abused, neglected and abandoned children and their families.
- Idaho Network of Child Advocacy Centers: Assists in developing and maintaining standards for Child Advocacy Centers.
- Local Law Enforcement: Garden City Police Department, Meridian Police Department, and Ada County Sheriff's Office, along with Boise Police Department, all played a role in the creation of Faces of Hope and continue to support the Victim Center in various ways. These departments and other Treasure Valley agencies utilize the Victim Center for victim services, a place to conduct investigations and trainings.
- St. Luke's CARES (Children At Risk Evaluation Services) Clinic: Accredited child advocacy center that provides medical exams, forensic interviews and victim advocacy services for children who are victims of abuse and neglect. CARES also provides trainings on child abuse topics.
- St. Luke's Faces Clinic: Provides medical care for adult victims of domestic violence, sexual assault and elder abuse.
- Community Sexual Assault Team: Comprised of nurses from St. Luke's and Saint Alphonsus with specialized training and education to provide medical treatment to patients who have experienced acute sexual assault or domestic violence. Care of these patients includes examination, assessment, treatment, and gathring of forensic evidence throughout treatment.
- University of Idaho College of Law, Legal Clinic: Under the supervision of a clinical faculty member, third year law students help victims of abuse with protection orders and various other civil legal matters.

Our Partners



The Center is designed so that people affected by abuse can access all relevant services and support through a single door. Our specialized multi-disciplinary team, made up of 12 in-house partners, wraps around an individual or family and provides crisis-intervention services to stabilize them. 
