

## A WORD FROM OUR BOARD PRESIDENT

Last year, Faces of Hope provided support to an average of 18 people per day. I want to share a few personal stories that resonated with me last year.

Sophie, a teenage girl, was sexually abused by two family members. Lori, endured 25 years of intimidation, isolation, coercion, and economic abuse by her husband, yet she didn't know she was a victim because "she wasn't physically beaten." David was emotionally, financially, and physically abused by his wife and revealed his experience for the first time to his counselor at the center. And Beverly, an elderly mother, took in her ill-stricken adult son, only to have him take over her home, freedom, and finances.

These women and men endured great trauma. However, because they found Faces of Hope and were given the medical, legal, and emotional support they needed, they discovered HOPE.

Through the generous community support from organizations and individuals like you, Faces of Hope provides a complete safety net of services to victims of domestic violence, sexual assault, child abuse, elder abuse, and stalking. The best part is that all of our services are immediate and at no cost to the victim.

On behalf of the more than 2,000 individuals we provided services to in 2019, and the 18 individuals who will seek support today, thank you for helping ensure Faces of Hope provides immediate wrap-around services to every victim that comes through our door.




